

## Then Feed Just One

You are invited to participate in the Then Feed Just One (TFJO) food packaging event that will occur on, April 11, 2017, that is Tuesday of Holy Week, an appropriate time for almsgiving. This is a wonderful, community & area-wide event that supports the poor of the world. The event will be hosted at St. Mary's High School. Many of you have participated in TFJO in past years and it is our hope that faculty and students, the Remsen businesses and community, and those from neighboring areas will again support this event.

TFJO borrowed a quote from Mother Theresa, "**If you cannot feed one hundred people, then feed just one.**" It is an effort to help provide food to some of the neediest people in the world, the people of Honduras. Hunger is a serious threat.

The global poor are a population that loses 40,000 people worldwide per day to hunger. If that were happening here at that rate, by the end of this year every man, woman, and child in Iowa would be gone.

### This program works in two phases

#### Phase I collecting money.

Due to the nature of this program, a healthy meal can be provided to a starving person for only 16 cents. Your registration fee covers the cost of supplies and the shipping to Honduras.

#### Phase II Packing Food for Shipping.

This is where we pack the food with the raised funds for shipment to Honduras, where some of the poorest people in the world live. This will occur on Tuesday, April 11, at St. Mary's High School in the Sandy Augustine Memorial Gym. If you would like to work the event, we ask your donation of \$30 along with your registration form. Please fill out the registration form below and drop off or mail to one of the places noted. The goal this year is to ship 133,000 meals to Honduras from this packaging event to the poorest of the poor in the world. You may donate to sponsor a student(s) if you wish. Registration & donation checks should be made to RSM TFJO. Your registration by March 28 will aid in ordering ample supplies.
