Yard Waste

Yard waste may be hauled to the collection site north of town. Follow Marion Street heading north and turn right at Quest Ave.

OBEY THE SIGNS!



Wood, etc. *These must be taken to the landfill.*

NO Plastic, Glass, Metal, Furniture, Mattress, Carpet,

NO Open Burning in City limits!

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Only city-issued containers will be picked up.
- Only waste in the container will be picked up, not waste sitting by or on it.
- Container must be upright, lid closed, push handle/wheels facing away from the street, and at the edge of the curb or driveway.
- No Permanent Solid Waste Container shall be kept or maintained in a front yard, except for collection. Residential containers shall **not** be placed at the curb more than twelve (12) hours in advance of the regularly scheduled collection day and shall be promptly removed from the curb line following collection.
- Containers need to be stored on private property and not City right-of-way.
- There is no need to bag your recycling. However using clear or see-through bags ensures the contents will stay contained if the container should blow over





FINES

Fines will apply up to \$500 if appliances, tires, fluorescent light fixtures, paints, stains or household hazardous chemicals are found in roll off containers, or any load dumped in C&D area or Transfer Station.
