Any service line that does not have a completed form will require an onsite inspection by City of Remsen staff.

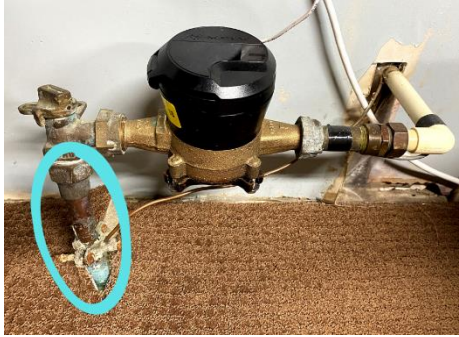

Copper service line at water meter

Your service line is the pipe that connects the water main to your house or business. This pipe brings water inside the house/ business and is owned by you/the property owner.

It brings water to your meter, usually in the basement.



Lead: Non-magnetic, silver-gray color. Easily scratches with a coin.

Copper: Non-magnetic, color of copper penny.



Galvanized steel: Magnetic, gray color.

Plastic: Non-magnetic, usually blue or black, rigid pipe.
